Art Unit Overview: Year 5 Autumn 1 – Textiles – Ancient Greece

Context: In this unit, you will continue to develop your textiles skills to create a small 3D Greek urn. You will work from photographs and digital images to create a design and will experiment with pleating, sewing and tassels to decorate your urn. You will explore the work of different artists, thinking about what you like or dislike about their work. Once your urn is completed, you will compare your work with others, saying what you think and feel about them before explaining what you would do differently next time.

Key Questions: What were Greek urns used for? What images were used on Greek urns? What techniques will you use to create your urn?

Previous steps
In Year 3, you experimented with a range of different techniques e.g. printing, dyeing and weaving to create different effects. You developed your stitching, cutting and joining skills as well as applying decoration using beads, buttons and feathers. You researched and discussed patchwork before making a class

your own design working from photographs and images that you have found. You will create a 3D object and use your experimentation with weaving, plaiting, sewing, tassels and overlapping different media to decorate it. You will investigate how to create interesting colours, textures and effects that can be used in your design.
