Relationship & Sex Education – Parent Information day – Tuesday 4th February

RSE (Relationship and Sex Education) legally become part of children’s curriculum in 2019.

The RSE curriculum covers:

- Friendships, different types of friends
- Friendship difficulties and bullying
- Relationship between families
- Celebrating family differences
- Differences between relationships (people we know & people we don’t)
- Knowing about the human body
- Knowing how bodies grow and change
- Understanding how they will change & grow, puberty (years 5 - compulsory science curriculum)
- Different types of relationships - emotional and physical
- Living things producing offspring (years 6 - compulsory science curriculum)

We have worked alongside **Hackney Council School Support** to ensure correct coverage and year group progression. We will be sharing this content and coverage with parents next Wednesday; this will provide an outline of the curriculum as well as address any questions you may have.
