


Guide to Google Meets

Why do we 'meet' in the morning?

The morning Google Meet is a key part of your child's day of home learning. All children at home are expected to attend every day. It is a chance for them to see their teacher and to find out about the day's learning. Your child's teacher will explain how to achieve the tasks set and provide feedback on learning that has been handed in. It is also an opportunity for the children to see each other and feel connected to their class team. A register is kept each day of the children who attend and you will receive a phone call if your child has not attended the meet.

How do I join?

1. Sign in to Google Classroom and find your child's class 'stream'.
2. The meet link will become visible when the meeting is ready to begin.
3. Click the link to enter at the start time of the meet.

- Join **on time**
- Join using your **school** Google account
- Turn your **camera on**
- **Mute** your microphone
- Show great 'green' listening and respond with thumbs up or down

Please don't

- Arrive late
- Unmute unless asked to
- Join using a personal email address
- Change your background – it can distract others
