







Year 1 Home Learning Menu - Summer 1

Add as many facts as you can, including important dates you remember.</p>	<p>This half term, you are going to learn about maps. You will create your own map of a familiar route. 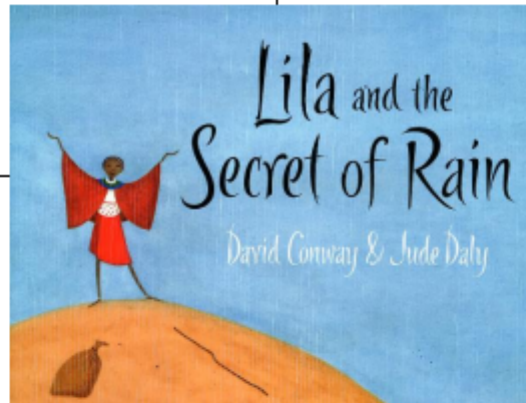
